

CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP OF WAGGA WAGGA COUNTRY CLUB LTD

When a person is nominated for membership of the Wagga Wagga Country Club Ltd they must observe the following rules:

ALL MEMBERS

1. A person being proposed for membership must be nominated and seconded by a financial member of the club of at least six months standing.
2. Upon lodgement of their completed nomination form together with their payment, they shall become Provisional Members and may use the Club facilities and golf course.
3. All members must observe dress regulations, both on the golf course and in the clubhouse.

PLAYING MEMBERS

4. To obtain a golf handicap a player must submit at least three completed cards, verified by a member, to the club handicapper AFTER the Board has approved their membership
5. A player is not eligible to participate in Club competition rounds until their handicap is displayed on the board
6. During all rounds of golf a player is required to carry a sand bucket and fill in all divots
7. Playing members, country members, junior members and senior members may use the golf course for no green fee. They MUST however, report to the Pro Shop before teeing off.
8. Golf is a game that depends a great deal on tradition and long established custom for its charm.
9. The standards required should extend to the choice of dress and general conduct on the course and in the clubhouse. It cannot be too strongly emphasised that the fundamental rule is consideration to one's fellow members.
